The defendant must post bond in the amount specified. Upon receipt of the defendant's bond and written forfeiture indicating a plea the court will order bond forfeiture upon the matter following signature of the defendant.

Ohio Traffic Rule 10(B) Effect of guilty or no contest pleas

With reference to the offense or offenses to which the plea is entered:

- (1) The plea of guilty is a complete admission of the defendant's guilt.
- (2) The plea of no contest is not an admission of defendant's guilt, but is an admission of the Truth of the facts alleged in the complaint and such plea or admission shall not be used against the defendant in any subsequent civil or criminal proceeding.
- (3) When a plea of guilty or no contest is accepted pursuant to this rule, the court shall proceed with sentencing under Criminal Rule 32, the court therefore will impose as for bond forfeiture a fine of \$45.00 and court costs.
